Subject: Automated License Data System (ALDS) – Licensed Domesticated Migratory Game Bird Shooting Areas

Dear WILLIAM HARRISON:

Beginning September 1, 2011, the Department of Fish and Game (DFG) will make the Nonresident One-Day Hunting License and/or Upland Game Bird privilege available on DFG's online license sales site at [www.dfg.ca.gov/licensing/ols/](http://www.dfg.ca.gov/licensing/ols/). This site is accessible 24 hours a day seven days a week. This provides a convenient option for Licensed Game Bird Club customers to purchase these items and for clubs without ALDS terminals to continue to offer this service to their clients.

Hunters who have purchased a license using the new ALDS may proceed to our on-line license sales site or visit a DFG office. However, all new Hunters will need to provide their personal identification (i.e., driver's license, DMV identification, birth certificate) and proof of hunter education (i.e. hunter education certificate, current hunting license or a hunting license issued within the previous two years from another state) to DFG before they can purchase a Nonresident One-Day Hunting License and/or Upland Game Bird Validation online

Several options are available for new Hunters:

- Faxed a request along with their personal identification and proof of hunter education to DFG at (916) 419-7587.

DFG will be communicating this information through our website, upcoming press releases and other materials. We are also asking for your assistance to ensure that your customers are informed of this requirement and have sufficient time to plan ahead to provide the information necessary to purchase their license online.
